

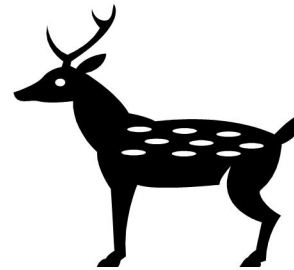


Historic Fort Steuben

Welcome to Historic Fort Steuben, built to protect surveyors of the Northwest Territory.

In 1786, in order to raise money to pay its debts from the War of Independence, the United States government began the immense job of surveying and selling (or giving away as land grants) the land of the Northwest Territory. Fort Steuben was built to protect the surveyors as they surveyed the Seven Ranges of Ohio.

Fun Fact: The drum was important for the army; the different beats were signals for the men to wake up, march, fire, or retreat.



Fun Fact: Deer was a valuable animal on the frontier; it was a source of meat and clothing, and deer fat was used as an insect repellent!
