2024 YOUTH EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM

Historic Fort Steuben will host a week-long educational program for 4th to 6th graders this summer. The children will focus on life at the Fort, our area's history and culture and will learn by a "hands on" approach. Students are asked to bring a sack lunch. Historic Fort Steuben is a reconstruction of an 18th century fort on the original site overlooking the Ohio River.

MONDAY Native Americans in the Ohio Valley in the 18th Century
Learn about the different cultures and crafts of the tribes that called the Ohio Valley home

TUESDAY A Day in the Life of a Soldier at Fort Steuben
Participate in the activities of both the officers and enlisted men and use Baron von Steuben's drill manual

WEDNESDAY Be It Ordained- Self-Government in the Northwest Territory
Discover how Ohio became a state through the Northwest Ordinance and learn to use the tools and techniques of surveyors.

THURSDAY Come Dig in the Dirt
Uncover hidden treasures at the archaeological site in the Fort.
Find out what archaeologists do with the artifacts back at the lab.

FRIDAY Lewis and Clark
Explore the west and travel along with the Lewis and Clark Expedition
Learn about the Eastern Legacy, the Ohio River & flintknapping
